Opaque

This material is not "see-through" which makes it ideal for privacy or construction sites. "Coming soon" signs block debris and dirt on the inside of your site. Use signage to advertise your grand opening, website or contact information.

A Closer Look

Apply vinyl cut lettering or a logo to door. It is a subtle branding opportunity and also can communicate information such as hours of operation. Go bold with storefront graphics that attract new customers or add color to corporate settings.

Do you need a balance between privacy and functionality? Dusted crystal and frosted window films offer a middle ground. Used for corporate, conference room or office space applications.

Translucent
